

REPORT OF 23 JULY 2020

1. Mr Grégoire Clamart, permanent resident of Monpazier moves setting up a participatory democracy programme in order to enhance the relationship between the village community and the City hall and to give the residents a say on the projects for the village of Monpazier.

That way, the residents of Monpazier could to both express their opinion about City Hall council projects and put forward their own suggestions, always respecting the rules and regulations of Batiments de France institution.

By next fall, a questionnaire flyer will be drafted and sent to the community. A public meeting will be convened by Mr Clamart in order to give further information.

D01. The Mayor reminds the City Hall council that the restoration work on Saint Dominique Church must continue.

The next conditional stage focuses on the northern aspect/elevation of the building, the side chapels and on repairs to the northern part of the roof of the nave.

The financial partners (region, department, State Ministry) have given their approval.

The estimated cost of this stage is 160,000 EUROS (tax not included) and the call for tender procedure should start soon.

The City Hall council gives a unanimous vote in favour of the proposal.

D02. Mr Lavarenne reports about the project and the financing of the rain water sewer system. Several banks were approached.

The City Hall council has chosen CAISSE EPARGNE AQUITAINE POITOU CHARENTES. This bank will be financing a 43,500 EUROS loan for this programme.

D03. Mr Lavarenne reports on the financing of the church restoration programme. Several banks were approached. The City Hall council has chosen CAISSE EPARGNE AQUITAINE POITOU CHARENTES. This bank will be financing a 80,000 EUROS loan for this programme.

D04. The Mayor of Monpazier moves launching a sponsoring drive with Fondation du Patrimoine in order to finance the St Dominique Church conservation-restoration work.

Mr Lacombe, the man in charge of this initiative, reports he has already contacted several people and gives information on the procedure to be followed in order to secure Fondation du Patrimoine sponsorship.

He offers to convene a meeting with the mayors of the former Canton de Monpazier in order to draw up a comprehensive sponsoring programme to support them with their various conservation-restoration projects.

The City Hall council unanimously accepts the idea. Mr Lacombe will .

D05. The Mayor reports that it has been necessary to purchase a showcase to display items made by Monpazier craftsmen/women on the premises of the Office du Tourisme.

This piece of furniture has been bought online by the Mayor. The City Hall Council agreed to pay him back for that purchase.

Questions diverses/ Any other business:

The Major reports that SMD3 will provide Monpazier with two free collective compost bins.

A public meeting will be convened next fall to explain how to use the compost facility efficiently.

In order to prevent further acts of vandalism actions and fights in Monpazier, resource persons will be appointed to liaise with the Gendarmerie.

An officer of the Gendarmerie will give a workshop regarding this programme.

The Major reports that the municipality will purchase a battery powered utility tricycle for minor maintenance and cleaning work (public toilets, waste bins), in order to cut back on the use of municipal vehicles and save money in the process.
