

## Monday, October 5<sup>th</sup> – City Hall Council meeting Report

### D01 : Church/ Renovation work/ Final choice for contractor

The Major gave the information that the church renovation work is about to start and therefore a contractor has to be chosen.

The City Hall Council decides to offer the renovation work project to APAVE. The financing for this project is 1,680.00 EUROS before tax.

### D02 : Opening for a Communal work position

A 35 hr/week work position is offered to an acclaimed candidate. The contract will be effective by January 4<sup>th</sup> 2021.

### Any other business :

A feed back of finished and scheduled work is given to the City Hall Council.

CCBDP is leading the organization of the wastewater treatment plant. Work will be starting on mid- October, with archaeological excavations. The first step of this work project will be starting by November up to the end of March. The second step will be taking place on next winter. A resource flyer and phone number will be available for residents if incidents need to be reported.

The “pétanque” playground has just been renovated.

The Hotel de France building permit has been approved on September 10<sup>th</sup> 2020.

The cemetery walking paths have been re-vegetated.

## Communication :

A communal magazine project has been introduced. The goal of this publication is to value the communication between City Hall Council and residents of Monpazier.

This magazine will be published 4 times a year (spring, summer, fall and winter) and will introduce a few different topics all about “esprit Bastide” of Monpazier.

A new website is on progress as well as a movie which will value Monpazier.

A 18,000 EUROS subsidy has been approved by Région Aquitaine in order to finance a few communication tools.

## Meetings

On October 28<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm, a ceremony will be taking place in front of the memorial. This ceremony will be set up by the Veterans association.

Monpazier has been re- awarded as “Plus beau Village de France” and re- labelled as “Ville des Métiers d’Art”.

Furthermore, Monpazier received an award as “Commune Touristique” from the Préfecture.
